In order to save time the customary "Company's Grace" and Loving Cups will be omitted.

A Menu has been selected in consultation with Ring & Brymer Itd. (Fishmongers Company employ these caterers exclusively). The price will be £2.14.0 per head, including Champagne to be served during the Sweet course. Extras will consist of £12.12.0 for floral decorations and Jamaica Cigars will on this occasion be supplied by the Caterers costing 2/9d. each. Cigarettes will be additional.

It was decided that the Livery should be invited and to bring one lady. Guests of the Court to be at discretion.
