 were audited and compared with the several Vouchers Audit
 appears thereby that he has disbursed on their Account
 256[£] 9^s 5^d and received for their Use 244[£] 14^s 7^d making
 a Balance of 11[£] 14^s 10^d due to him from the Company
 Which was paid over to him this day by the present Master

The Clerk's Account for the same year was also audited
 by which it appears that he has disbursed for their Use
 the sum of 65[£] 10^s 2^d and received on their Account
 59[£] 18^s 6^d making a Balance of 5[£] 11^s 6^d due to him from
 the Company Which was also paid by the Master
 to him.

The Bradles Account for the same year was likewise
 audited making a Balance of 9[£] 19^s 0^d due to him from
 the Company after deducting 10[£] for Quarterage collected
 by him to Christmas last and other monies received by
 him on Account. Which Balance the Master this day
 paid him.
