Report of the Committee as to the Company's Finances

In pursuance of the Resolution of the Court on the 25th April last your Committee have again met and were assisted in their deliberations by Mr J. Harwood Tescher and Sir Homewood Crawford

With a view to reducing the Company's annual expenses the Committee beg to make the following recommendations to the Court:

Free Guest Tickets

1. That the issue of free Guest Tickets to Members of the Court other than the Master Wardens and Treasurer be abolished
2. That the Master be allowed six free Guest Tickets instead of eight as heretofore, the Wardens and Treasurer three instead of four and the Clerk one instead of four
