139. The Band of the Coldstream Guards

Formed in 1650 by George Monck, a General in Oliver Cromwell's New Model Army, this can claim to be one of the oldest regiments in the world. In 1661, it was re-commissioned by King Charles II as Household Troops from the town of Coldstream. From the earliest days, the regiment had drummers and a 'Band of Music' from 1785. The Band of the Coldstream Guards has now enjoyed more than 200 years of continuous military service, making it one of the oldest military bands in the world.



140. Sheriff

Sheriff Nigel Pullman is accompanied by his Chaplain, The Reverend Bertrand Olivier. The Sheriff's personal standard and the standard of his Livery Company, the Worshipful Company of Leathersellers, are carried by cadets of 1475 (Dulwich) Squadron, Air Training Corps. Two Doggett's Coat and Badge men are on the stand at the rear of the carriage.



141. Aldermanic Sheriff

The Sheriff's personal standard and the standard of his Livery Company, the Worshipful Company of Shipwrights, are carried by cadets of 1475 (Dulwich) Squadron, Air Training Corps. Two Doggett's Coat and Badge men are on the stand at the rear of the carriage.



142. Late Lord Mayor

The outgoing Lord Mayor and Lady Mayoress, Alderman and Mrs David Wootton, are accompanied by Alderman Wootton's Chaplain, The Reverend Andrew Walker. The carriage is escorted by four Yeoman Warders of HM Tower of London and cadets of 1475 (Dulwich) Squadron, Air Training Corps, who carry the Alderman's personal standard and the standard of his Livery Company, The Worshipful Company of Fletchers. Two Doggett's Coat and Badge men are on the stand at the rear of the carriage.

145. Light Cavalry HAC

The Light Cavalry was formed in 1861, as a reconnaissance force for the HAC infantry battalions. That role ended in 1891. In 1979, the unit reformed as a ceremonial squadron. Its primary duty is the provision of a mounted escort for the Lady Mayoress.
