The Master moved that Trinity College of Music be once more added to the list of Musical Institutions qualified to recommend Medalists for the Company, and this was seconded by Mr. W. H. Ash.

Letters were read from P. M. Chamier, suggesting that as any action in the matter would be so clearly in the nature of a rescinding of a previous resolution of the Court, it was not competent for the Court to consider it at that meeting, but that formal notice should be given of the intention to re-open the subject at a future meeting; from P. W. Wyatt, in opposition to the motion; and from Mr. Falkner, urging that some way ought to be found of putting an end to the dispute, so as to preserve harmony. After discussion, Mr. Sullivan moved as an amendment that the matter should be adjourned for consideration by a future Court, but this amendment was not seconded and on being put to the vote the Master's motion was carried by a large majority. The Clerk was instructed to accept the nomination by Dr. G. W. Pearce of the Trinity College of Music, of Mr. Frank Bilbe, as the Company's Silver Medalist for the year. P. M. A. F. Hill and Messrs W. H. Leslie and H. D. Truscott J. P. were appointed a committee to settle the programme of music to be performed by the Students of the Royal Academy of Music at the Livery Dinner.
