D. M. Sir Home Wood Crawford proposed the election of Mr Henry George Wymethorn and this was seconded by Mr Gobbett. Objection was raised that as Mr Gobbett was the Secretary of the Guildhall School of Music his election as an Assistant might possibly be inconvenient and lead to difficulty in dealing with matters in which the Guildhall School of Music were concerned but on being put to the vote Mr George Wymethorn's election was carried.

The filling of the second vacancy was discussed at length and on the suggestion of D. M. Hill supported by D. M. de La Fontaine it was unanimously decided to offer Sir Jan Zachary Malcolm K.C.M.G. a seat upon the Council and failing his acceptance to offer the seat to Sir Hugh Percy Allen M.A., Mus. Doc., the Director of the Royal College of Music.

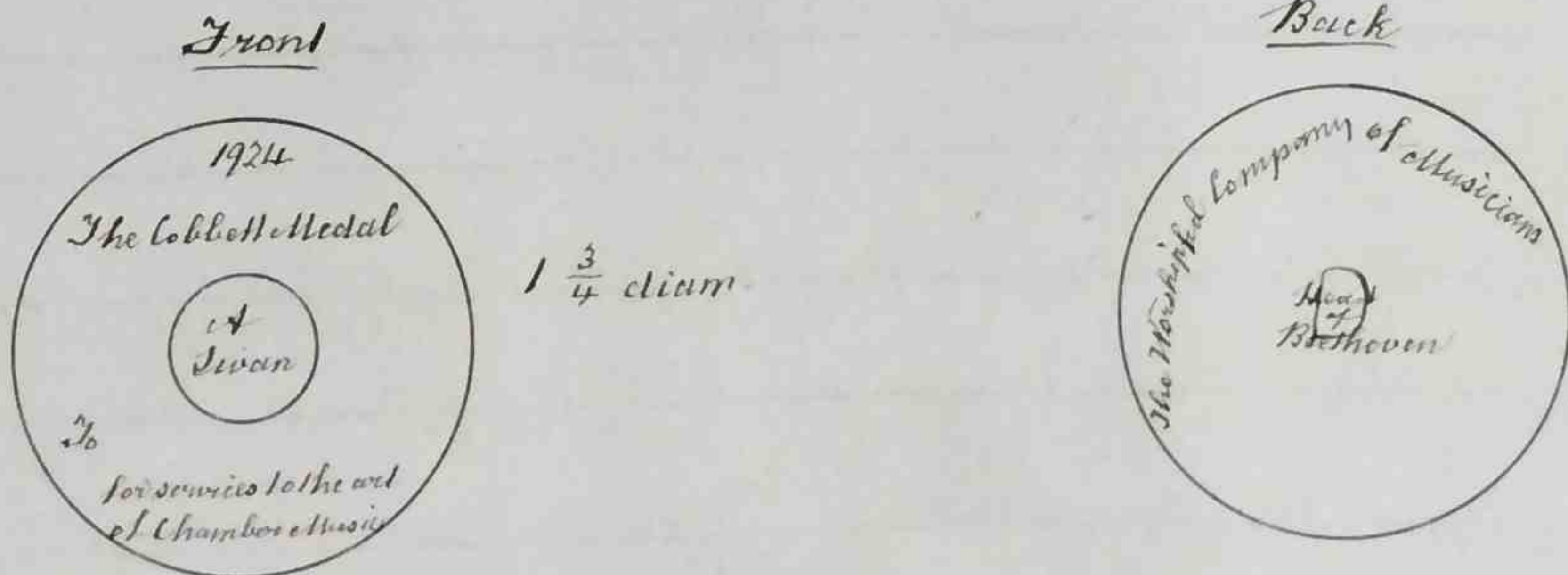
W. W. Gobbett Esq
