A letter was read from Sir Hubert Parry Bart. C.V.O. Mus Doc the Director of the Royal College of Music recommending M<sup>r</sup> Maurice Soder a Young Violoncellist as the fittest person to receive the Leo Stern Scholarship and the recommendation was approved

Masters Cup

The Treasurer presented a large handsome double handled Silver Cup which he said had been subscribed for by Members of the Court and the Clerk to commemorate the fact that the office of Master had been held by the Lord Mayor

The Cup bears the following inscription "A Gift from the Court to the Company to mark the unique event that in 1908-9 'The Right Hon. Sir George Wyatt Tinscott Bart. was Lord Mayor of London and Master of the Worshipful Company of Musicians 26<sup>th</sup> October 1909' The Master thanked the Court for their gift and said he was proud to think that his name would be thus commemorated in the Company's annals
