147. Household Cavalry Mounted Regiment

While first and foremost an operational regiment, deploying regularly to Afghanistan and elsewhere, the HCMR also provides the Sovereign's Escort and Queen's Life Guard in its mounted State Ceremonial role. Comprising The Life Guards and The Blues and Royals, the HCMR annually honours the longstanding bond between the Sovereign and Lord Mayor by providing a mounted escort for the Show.



148. City Marshal

Colonel Billy King-Harman CBE. The City Marshal is one of the Lord Mayor's three Esquires (personal staff officers).



149. The Rt Hon The Lord Mayor of London, Alderman Roger Gifford

The Lord Mayor rides in the 18th-century gold State Coach drawn by six shire horses, and preceded by Doggett's Coat and Badge men. His personal standard and the standard of his Mother Livery Company, The Worshipful Company of Musicians, are carried by members of the Company of Pikemen and Musketeers of the Honourable Artillery Company. The Lord Mayor is attended by his Chaplain and two of his Esquires (personal staff officers).
