It is suggested that a silver gilt badge of the size of a crown piece be presented to each past master, the cost of making this die would be £4.15.0 and the actual cost of the badges with ring 7/ each. For the use of the other members of the Court a silver gilt badge of the size of a four shilling piece is suggested the cost of this die would be £4.10.0 and the badges 6/ each. It is further suggested that a silver badge with ring of the size of a half crown piece be presented to every member of our Company on taking up the livery the cost of this die would be £4.0.0 and the badges 3/6 each, if cases are required they
