

And John Freeman was also proposed by Mr Williams
and seconded by Mr Rutter for the like purpose.

And that Notice of such Election be inserted in the Summons for the next Court
It was moved and seconded That the Treasurer be requested to
pay One hundred pounds to the Master to defray the
demands on the Company; which the Treasurer paid
accordingly.

It was afterwards Ordered that the Treasurer buy 100 [£] Stock
in the Old South Sea Annuities in Addition to the Funds of
the Company.
