Publication of Lectures delivered at the Music Loan Exhibition Mr Southgate reported that the ordinary copies of the Lectures had been published and that the special copies in half calf would be issued shortly and on the suggestion of Sir Homewood Crawford it was decided that special copies should be sent to the King, Queen Alexandra The Prince and Princess of Wales, The Lord Mayor and Sheriff in Office during the Exhibition and the Prime Warden Wardens and Clerk of the Fishmongers Company in office at the same time and it was left with the Master and Sir Homewood Crawford to send any other copies they might think fit

On the proposition of Sir Homewood Crawford seconded by the Master a cordial vote of thanks was accorded to Mr Southgate for the great trouble
