Heads of Proposed Arrangement between the Worshipful Company of Stationers and the Worshipful Company of Musicians with reference to the use of Stationers Hall

The Musicians Company to be entitled to use of Hall with Court Room Reception Rooms &c for their four Quarterly Courts and Dinners on dates convenient to the Stationers Company and on any other special occasion at a convenient date

The Musicians Company to be entitled to keep their plate &c in the Strong Room at Stationers Hall such plate to be kept in a box or chest to be provided by the Musicians Company

The Musicians Company to have the exclusive use of the cellar on the West side now vacant the key of such cellar being retained by the Clerk of the Musicians Company

The Musicians Company to fully insure their own plate wine and other property and the Stationers Company not to be liable with regard to such
