It was resolved that the medal could only be given to a student of the present year and the Clerk was instructed to request Sir Alexander Mackenzie to nominate another student who would comply with this condition.

Trinity College of Music

(Sir Joseph Thorneycroft Mayor)
The Master moved that the presentation of the Company's Silver Medal to Trinity College of Music should be repeated and this was seconded by the Deputy Master. P. M. Sir Fredk Bridge as Chairman of Trinity College of Music stated that he thought the withdrawal of the medal might cause great friction in musical circles and appealed to the Lord Mayor not to press his motion. After discussion P. M. Sir Homewood Crawford moved the previous question which was seconded by P. M. Mayor Chamber and unanimously carried and the Clerk was instructed to inform the Secretary of the College that the vote of the medal in 1917 was limited to that year only.
