It was unanimously resolved to make the following recommendations to the Court viz

1 That the Livery fine and fees including stamps &c be increased from £13.6.0 to 50 Guineas (£52.10.0) Such increase to take effect in the case of Members elected after the next Court

2 That it be a general instruction to the Treasurer to invest £30 of all fees received from new Swerymen

3 That the following fine be in future paid by the Master and Wardens on taking Office viz

(a) On election to the Office of Junior Warden £5.5.0

(b) On election to the Office of Senior Warden £5.5.0

(c) On election to the Office of Master £10.10.0

4 That it be left to the discretion of the Treasurer to invest any amount received from Members on election to the Court as circumstances permit
