

The Account of the late Master Edward Ratten Esq^r
 was then audited by comparing same with the
 several Bills & Vouchers And it appears thereby
 that he has received for the Company's Use the
 sum of 34[£] 10^s 7^d and paid and disbursed on
 their account ... 26[£] 12^s 11^d making a Balance of
 7[£] 17^s 8^d as due from him to the Company
 Which on being found correct was approved of
 and this day paid over by him to Mr. Skilbeck
 Esq^r the present Master for the Use of the Company.

Mr. Daniel Wood the Clerk's Account for the last year
 was likewise audited Whereby it appears that a
 Balance of 2[£] 12^s 8^d is due from this Company to
 him Which also being found correct and approved
 of was this day paid by the said Mr. Skilbeck to him.

Mr. Readle's Account for the last year was also
 presented to this Committee When after deducting
 the sum of 8[£] 10^s for Quarterage as collected by
 him from the Freemen of this Company to October
 last it appears that the sum of 7[£] 10^s is due to
 him from the Company; and on the same being
 approved was this day paid to him by the
 Master.

The Book of Stamp duties payable on admission of Freemen during the Master-
 ship of Edward Ratten Esq^r was then examined, And the Committee find that
 7[£] 0^s 0^d paid for same is correct, as charged in the Master &
 Clerk's Accounts.
