M^r Andrew Carnegie attended and was introduced by the Wards
The Master then directed the Clerk to read the Resolution conferring the
Freedom of the company upon M^r Carnegie which was done and on the proposition
of M^r F. Harwood Lescher seconded by Sir Homewood Crawford it was
unanimously resolved that the Declaration of a Freeman be administered

The Declaration was then administered by the Clerk and M^r Carnegie
signed the Roll of Honorary Freemen and also the Roll of Freemen of
the company

right hand of fellowship and presented him with the scroll of the Freedom of
