

Finance Committee } The Report of the Finance Committee consisting of The Master and Messrs W. M. Wilkinson, J. C. Colvard and C. J. D. Crews was read and the following Resolutions were passed: -

Court Fine On the Proposition of the Master seconded by M^r Lescher, that the Court fine be raised from £35 to £50.

Livery Fine On the Proposition of the Master seconded by Sir J. Frederick Bridge that the Livery Fine be raised from £25 to £35.

Dinner Tickets and guests } On the Proposition of the Master seconded by M^r W. M. Wilkinson, that only one free guest Dinner Ticket per annum for the future be allowed to Members of the Court other than officers.

On the Proposition of the Master seconded by M^r W. M. Wilkinson that the Master be allowed two free guests Dinner Tickets and the Wardens respectively and the Treasurer one each at each of the Banquets.

On the Proposition of the Master seconded by M^r Crews that the price of guests Dinner Tickets be raised from twenty one shillings to thirty shillings. NB. This was subsequently reduced to 25/-

On the Proposition of the Master seconded by M^r Lescher that twiddle soup be not again had at any rate until after the Court Meeting in July next.
