The Committee audited the Account of Mr. T. Williams  
 the late Master and after having compared it with the several  
 Vouchers it appears that he has disbursed for the Use of the  
 Company 266<sup>£</sup> 7<sup>s</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> and received 262<sup>£</sup> 0<sup>s</sup> 0<sup>d</sup> making a Balance  
 of 4<sup>£</sup> 7<sup>s</sup> 8<sup>d</sup> due to him

The Clerk's Account of his Fees, Disbursements and  
 Salary amounting to 35<sup>£</sup> 15<sup>s</sup> 0<sup>d</sup> and of his Receipts for the  
 Company's Use to Michaelmas day last amounting to 12<sup>£</sup> 8<sup>s</sup> 8<sup>d</sup>  
 was also audited by which there appears to be due to him  
 23<sup>£</sup> 6<sup>s</sup> 4<sup>d</sup>

The Committee then proceeded to examine the List  
 of the Yeomanry of this Company and directed the  
 Clerk to write to several of them who have neglected  
 to take on them the Livery &c
