William Tothard, Son of John Tothard of Framlingham in the County of Suffolk Tallowmonger having produced an Indenture whereby it appears that he was bound on 5th April 1790 to Thomas Whittell Citizen and Musician of London and afterwards viz. 20th Feb^r 1798 turned over to John Crouch Citizen & Mathematician for the residue of the term of years and requesting to be admitted to the freedom of this Company by Certificate.
