Seventy seven pounds 7^s was examined, and
found correct.

The Clerk's Account was examined, and
found correct, leaving a Balance of four pounds
15^s 6^d due to him.

The Beadle's Account was audited,
and found correct: - it appeared that he had
received for Quarterage £6. 10. 0.

his Commissions 1. 7. 6
leaving a Balance of £5. 10. 6 due to the
Company which he then paid into the hands
of the Master.
