Treasurer's  
Accounts  
for 1912

The Treasurer presented his Accounts for 1912 a copy of which appears on the next page

In proposing the adoption of the Accounts the Master made certain suggestions which he thought would make the Accounts clearer with which the Treasurer concurred and on the proposition of the Master seconded by M<sup>r</sup> G. D. Hoblyn the Accounts were adopted and passed and a cordial vote of thanks was unanimously passed to the Treasurer for his services

Trust Funds

The Master suggested the advisability of keeping the Trust Accounts in future quite distinct from the general Funds and proposed the appointment of a small committee to consist of the Master, Wardens, Treasurer, M<sup>r</sup> Alderman and Sheriff Cooper (as one of the Trustees) and Sir Homewood Crawford to consider the matter

This was seconded by Captain Chamier and unanimously adopted

The Treasurer said that if any further Trust funds were given to the Company he thought such funds ought to be endowed with the necessary amount to meet the expenses of carrying out the trust and this was unanimously agreed to.
