The Committee appointed on the 8th day of October
^{to examine and audit the late Treasurer's accounts}

We of your Committee to whom on the 8th day of October
1800 it was referred to settle and audit the Treasurer's
accounts up to Michaelmas then last past, do certify
that since that period we have had repeated Meetings

said accounts and ascertaining what is due from him
to this Company and after minutely investigating the
same there did appear to us to be a Balance due
