Balance due to him from the Company of $\overset{\text{£. s. d.}}{56} \overset{\text{£. s. d.}}{0} \overset{\text{£. s. d.}}{8}$.

The Committee then proceeded to examine and audit the
Clerk's Account with this Company to the 10th October last
