 of his predeceasing his wife in my lifetime then as to the said sum of
 £1,000 for his said wife absolutely As to a sum of £100 each for each of
 the sons and daughters of my brothers and sisters absolutely As to the sum
 of £250 for Captain Bernard St. George Gollard R.N. absolutely As to the sum
 of £250 for the Music Trades Benevolent Society absolutely and as to the whole
 of the remainder thereof for the Worshipful Company of Musicians to be known
 as "The John Clementi Gollard Gift" and to be applied for the general purposes
 of the said Company And I direct that the receipts of the Treasurer or other
 proper officer for the time being of the said Music Trades Benevolent Society and
 the Worshipful Company of Musicians respectively shall be a sufficient discharge
 for the amounts paid in respect of such gifts to such Society and Company
 respectively Provided always And I declare that notwithstanding the trusts
 aforesaid each of them my said sons John Clementi Gollard and Cecil Clementi
 Gollard may by deed or by Will or Codicil appoint unto and for the benefit of any
 wife born during my lifetime of my said son who may survive him an interest
 (in priority to the said interest hereinbefore given to the children or child or
 remainder issue of my said son) as from his decease for her life or any less
 interest in the whole or any part of the income of the share (if any) hereby settled
 for the benefit of him and other the persons or person as aforesaid Provided
 also and I further declare that if either of my said sons John Clementi
 Gollard or Cecil Clementi Gollard shall assign charge or otherwise dispose of the
 income arising from his share whether original or derivative of my Residuary Trust
 Fund or any part thereof or shall become bankrupt or shall do or suffer
