The late Master's Accounts were audited and the  
Vouchers examined, and it appears thereby that he  
has received  $\text{£} 250. 4. 0$  for the Company's Use  
and disbursed on their Account  $\text{£} 101. 10. 0$  making  
a Balance of  $\text{£} 148. 14. 0$  due to the Company.

The Clerk's Accounts were also audited, whereby it  
appears that he has received  $\text{£} 59. 9. 2$  for their  
Use and expended  $\text{£} 3. 16. 4$  making a Balance  
of  $\text{£} 44. 7. 2$  due to him from the Company.

Also the Beadle's Account for the last Year up  
to Christmas 1816 deducting  $\text{£} 10. 0. 0$  for  
Quarterage as received by him to that Time  
making a Balance of  $\text{£} 10. 0. 0$  due to him from  
this Company.

The List of the Yeomanry was examined and several  
Persons selected therefrom to be written unto to  
take up their Livery at the ensuing Court.
