C.V.O. the Director of the Royal College of Music recommending Mr. Timothy Toomey a promising Violoncellist as the fittest person to receive the Leo Stern Scholarship and in the proposition of Mr. Hill seconded by Mr. Hunter the recommendation was unanimously approved

South London Musical Festival A further letter was read from the Secretary of the South London Musical Festival and Sir Homewood Crawford suggested that the Company might give a trophy to be won 3 years before becoming the absolute property of any choir but after discussion it was decided to let the matter stand over
