

- 8 Holders of the Scholarships selecting one of the string instruments as the principal study must in their second year attend the String Music Ensemble Class. Those who select a wind instrument as the principal study must in their second year attend the Wind Music Ensemble Class.
- 9 During the last term of tuition holders of the Scholarships shall subject to the direction of the Principal of the School undergo special instruction in the art of Teaching.
- 10 Holders of the Scholarships will bear the title of 'The Musicians Company Ernest Palmer Scholar' and be subject to a periodical report from the Principal of the School as to their satisfactory progress the Company expressly reserving to itself the right to withdraw the Scholarship at any time in the event of the report not being satisfactory. The Scholarship may be extended under special circumstances at the discretion of the Company.
- 11 Candidates for the Scholarships will be required to pay an entrance fee of 10/- on making application for liberty to compete such fee to be returned in the event of the applicant not being accepted for examination.
- 12 The Company reserves to itself the fullest power as to the selection or rejection of candidates.
