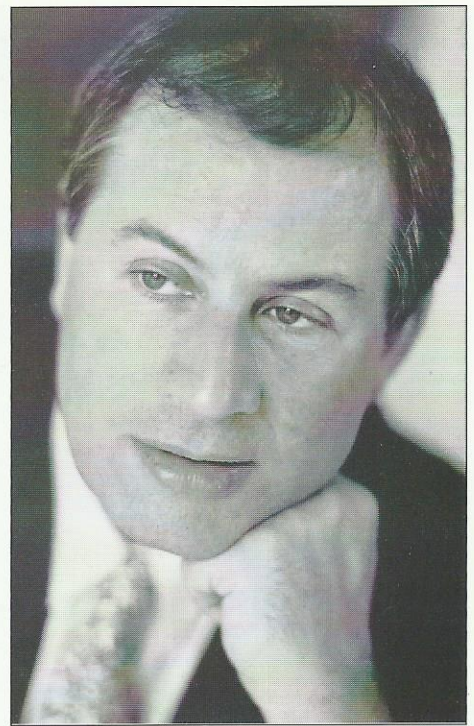

remain in a strong room, but be sold to enable a new generation of players and makers to benefit from this magnificent instrument. The proceeds would also finance the writing of a biography of her late husband and the issue of a CD of his classic recordings.

On the 20th of June 1995, I was present at a most exciting violin sale at Sotheby's in New Bond Street when two bidders took the sale of this splendid instrument far beyond the pre-sale estimate of £180,000 to sell, finally, for £375,000. The violin was bought by a violin dealer from Germany for his ten year old daughter who was invited to join the master classes of Pinchas Zukerman in Israel. Following the sale, Michelle Jenkins decided to devote funds to endow an annual award for the best bowed instrument made by students in musical instrument making at London Guildhall University. The course which was started early in the century at the Northern Polytechnic and later transferred to the London College of Furniture (where William Luff was at one time the teacher) has one of the most extensive musical instrument making courses in Europe. It attracts students from all over the world.

Victor Allcard Bequest

The Company has received the substantial residue of a fund left for the benefit of the recently deceased housekeeper to the late Pastmaster Victor Allcard. It has been added to the Allcard Fund.

Phyllis Barrett Luncheons

Liveryman Stephen Barrett has again been most generous in providing an additional capital grant to the fund he previously created in memory of his late wife. The purpose is to enable wives of Liverymen to enjoy the informal lunches which have now become a popular, regular and free function.

Benefit To Young Brass Players

The Chairman of the Brass Band Committee, Pastmaster John Iles, has organised a Deed of Variation in respect of the estate of a late aunt. As a result, the Company benefits from the 40% tax saving. The income will be used to augment the prize for the annual BBC2 competition to find the Best Brass Band from a Single School.

Kenn Golightly Bequest

The money left to the Company by the late Liveryman Kenn Golightly is to provide additional prizes for the London Harp Competition. The Company will therefore be able to donate the first three prizes in a category of this newly created bi-annual competition.

Ivor Mairants Guitar Award

Following the initiative of Liveryman Maurice Summerfield, who organised the Memorial Concert, a large audience gathered at the Wigmore Hall in February.

As Colin Cooper, General Editor of *Classical Guitar*, had foreseen, the event was, indeed, a demonstration by many who knew him of both their affection and admiration.

The All Star performers were Carlos Bonell, Juan Martín, Martin Taylor, the Eden-Stell Duo (Allcard Fund Recipients) and Amanda Cook (first Mairants Guitar Award Winner).

All the artists generously waived their fees thereby enhancing the funding of young musicians' projects, including our own Guitar Award established during Ivor's lifetime.

Meanwhile, Mrs Lily Mairants, Ivor's widow, has agreed to augment the original capital base of the fund by a further £10,000. The consequent value of the awards is likely to rise significantly in an area of musicianship that the Company has only recently been able to support.
