That, in the Event of the numerous Sivery of the Company being summoned to join in the Procession (whose Numbers amount to about Two Hundred) the unavoidable Expence of their Gowns, Cockades, Dinner and other necessary Articles (reckoning only on the Attendance of one half of their Number) would amount to upwards of Two Hundred Pounds independent of the Expence of Foot-Marshal's, Pensioners habited (customarily attending the Procession in Opulent Companies) which altho' generally borne, as they find, by the Lord Mayor, they have no Authority on the present Occasion to tax His Lordship with, and less so the Company; as, even in the more wealthy Companies, it is generally understood that their Members being called into great and honorable ostensible Situations, shall not be prejudicial to their respective Companies.

The Committee therefore, considering the great additional Expence which must result from the Attendance of
