THE LORD MAYOR'S ARRIVAL BY RIVER

This year Lord Mayor Gifford will arrive in the City by boat with a special flotilla in his honour. He will travel in the Royal Barge *Gloriana* as she makes her third official outing following this year's Thames Diamond Jubilee pageant and Olympic Torch Relay. The river procession times are as follows:

8.30am The Lord Mayor boards *Gloriana* and

takes the salute from the flotilla

8.35am Flotilla moves off down stream

with Gloriana at the rear

9.00am Waterloo Bridge

Blackfriars Bridge

9.10am Millennium Bridge

Southwark Bridge

of the Port of London, disembarks at HMS President by the Tower of London. He inspects a guard of honour and partakes of a tot of rum with the Commanding Officer, a historic naval ceremony. The Lord Mayor then makes his way by car back to the Guildhall.
