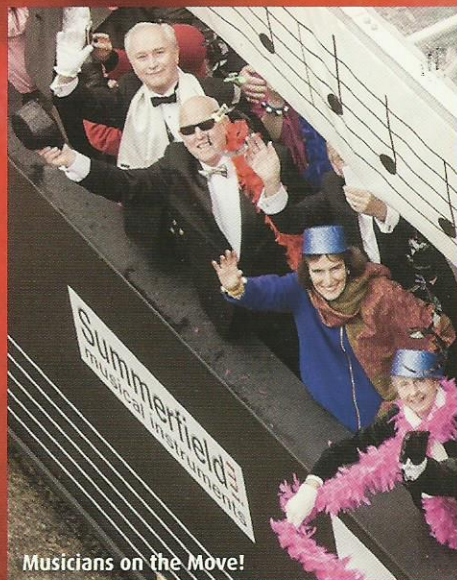


The Lord Mayor's Show 2012

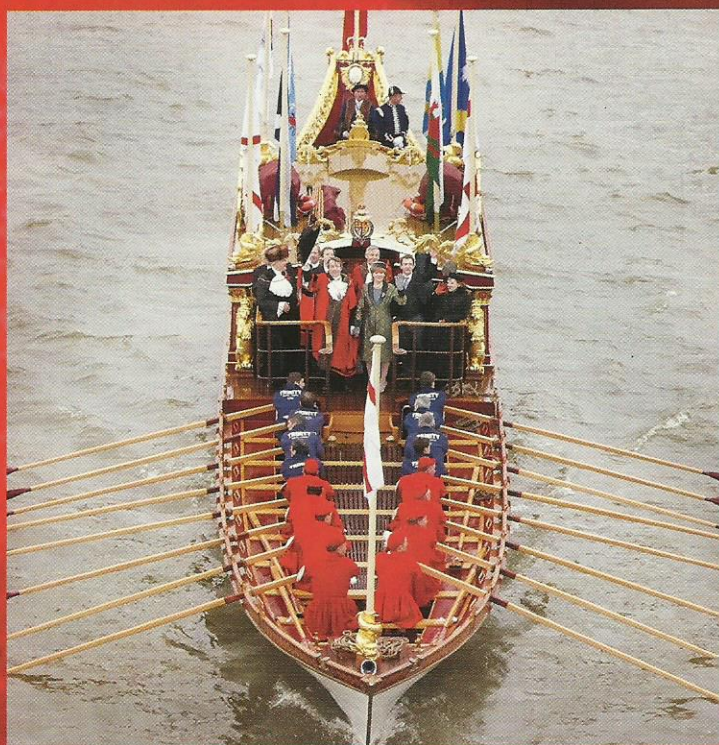
The day began when the Lord Mayor and Lady Mayoress travelled in QRB Gloriana (flying, amongst others, the flag of the Musicians' Company) from Vauxhall to HMS President, accompanied by a flotilla of 24 traditional Thames boats. After reviewing much of the Procession from Mansion House, the Lord Mayor then travelled in the 250 year old State Coach to St Paul's, where he and the Lady Mayoress received a Blessing, before continuing to the Royal Courts of Justice to give his oath of loyalty to the Sovereign before The Lord Chief Justice and High Court Judges. As the new Lord Mayor's Mother Livery Company, the Musicians' Company Float had pride of place at the head of the Procession with continuous live music provided by a team of Company organists and *Total Brass*, winners of the Royal Academy of Music Brass Ensemble Prize 2012.



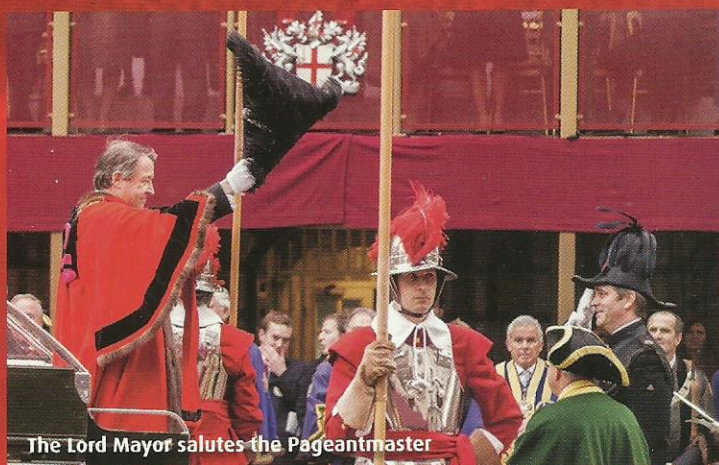
