the London Coffee House Ludgate Hill on Tuesday the 14th
day of June 1803.

The Committee in obedience to the directions of
the last Court proceeded to examine the List
of the several persons admitted to the Freedom of
this Company from the 22^d January 1801 (being the
time when the last payment of the Stamp duty -
thereon appears to have been made) to this day -
inclusive and Ordered the Clerk to discharge
the same forthwith. And also the Orphan duty
payable into the Chamber of London on binding
Apprentice s.

The Committee Ordered application to be made to
those of the Yeomanry who have had time granted
them for payment of their Fines and to several
others persons selected by the Committee from
the List.
