The Master paid 16 Members of the Court 10^s each
for early Attendance and Mr^s Robinson 5 Shillings
who came within time.

The Minutes of the last Court and Committee
and Business done since, were read and confirmed.

The Court Ordered that the several Bills as reported by
the last Committee, to be due from the Company, be
forthwith paid AND that the Treasurer do pay the
amount thereof into the hands of Mr^s Daniel Wood the
Clerk and that he be ordered to discharge the same
and produce the receipts at the next Court.

The Master declared a Vacancy in the Court and
also in the Trusteeship of this Company's Stock
by the death of William Chivers, Esq. whereupon
