A letter was read from Mr. A. J. Rowland Ramsey enquiring if he might use the Arms of the Company to embellish a Show Card he was designing for the use of the music trade and it was resolved that it was not desirable that permission should be given

Cripples Home

A further appeal from the Lord Mayor to assist in completing the necessary funds for his Cripples Home was read but it was resolved that having regard to the large amount subscribed through the Concert in the Spring nothing further could be done in the matter

Crosby Hall

A letter was read from Alderman Sir George Visery Strong asking for a contribution towards the preservation of Crosby Hall. The Master stated he thought that owing to the shortness of time at the disposal of the Committee the matter was not going through but on the proposition of Sir Frederick Bridge seconded by Mr. Hill, it was proposed to vote a donation of 10 Guineas if the matter went through and Dr. Southgate stated that Colonel Shaw-Hellier had offered to subscribe £5 on his own account. The Clerk was directed to communicate with Sir George Visery Strong accordingly
