That Mr Chappell be requested to send to The
Royal College of Music the sum of Forty Guineas
being the two instalments due for the past and present
years Seconded by Mr Wilkinson.
Carried unanimously.

Mr Theobald gave notice that at the next meeting of the
Court he should move that the Resolution passed on the
2nd of May 1882 as to the sum voted to the Royal College of
Music should be rescinded.
