

A Meeting of the Committee of the Worshipful Company of
Musicians, held at the Globe Tavern, Fleet Street on Wednesday
the 13th December 1815

The late Master's Accounts were audited and the Vouchers
examined And it appears thereby, that he has received
for the Company, ^{£. 20} 28^l 10^s 0^d and that he has disbursed
on their Account ^{£. 50} 29^l 0^s 4^d making a Balance of ^{£. 50} 17^l 0^s 4^d
due to him from the Company.

Also a Bill of ^{£. 50} 14^l 18^s 6^d for Stationary and Printing
to the 9 Dec^r 1815 being 2 years, was delivered by M^r.
Gough And examined and approved of by the Committee

The Clerk's Accounts for the last Year were also audited
and it appears thereby that he has received ^{£. 50} 23^l 5^s 4^d
for the Company's Use and expended ^{£. 50} 3^l 1^s 2^d making a
Balance of ^{£. 50} 14^l 4^s 10^d due to him from the Company.

Also the Madie's Account for the last Year, up to
Christmas 1815 deducting ^{£. 50} 10^l 10^s for Quarters as
received by him to that Time with an addition of 12^l
Shillings for Poundage on Quarters making a Balance
of ^{£. 50} 9^l 18^s 0^d due to him from the Company.
