The late Master's Accounts were audited and  
examined with the several Vouchers, whereby it appears  
that he has received for the Company's Use the sum of  
224<sup>£</sup> 19<sup>ⁱ</sup> 5<sup>ᵃ</sup> and expended on their Account  
199<sup>£</sup> 7<sup>ⁱ</sup> 7<sup>ᵃ</sup> making a Balance due from him  
of 25<sup>£</sup> 11<sup>ⁱ</sup> 10<sup>ᵃ</sup>

The Clerk's Account for the last year was also  
audited And it appears thereby that his Fees  
Salary and monies expended by him on the Company's  
Account amount to 56<sup>£</sup> 5<sup>ⁱ</sup> 10<sup>ᵃ</sup> and that he  
has received for their Use 35<sup>£</sup> 3<sup>ⁱ</sup> 4<sup>ᵃ</sup> making a  
Balance due to him of 21<sup>£</sup> 2<sup>ⁱ</sup> 6<sup>ᵃ</sup>

Also the Beadle's Account for the same year from  
which it appears that there is due to him from this  
Company 7<sup>£</sup> 17<sup>ⁱ</sup> 6<sup>ᵃ</sup> after deducting for Quaterage  
received by him the sum of 12<sup>£</sup>
