The Master paid Eleven Members of the Court 10<sup>s</sup> each for early attendance and Mr Steele 5 shillings who came within time

The Minutes of the last Court were read and confirmed

The Committee reported that they had audited the Treasurer's Account and compared same with the several Vouchers up to this day and find that a Balance of 11<sup>l</sup> 5<sup>s</sup> 8<sup>d</sup> remains in his hands due to this Company

Ciddes Mackenzie Simpson paid his Livery and Steward's fine and 2<sup>l</sup> 6<sup>s</sup> to the poor
