



51. F & G Companies, 7 RIFLES

7 RIFLES is a TA Infantry Battalion with Companies in Reading, Oxford, Milton Keynes, Mayfair and West Ham. It has a proud record of achievement, including recent operational service in Afghanistan. In 2012, the regiment celebrates the fifth anniversary of the formation of the Rifles and in June, 7 RIFLES was awarded the Honorary Freedom of the Borough of Newham.



52. 265 (Home Counties) Battery 106 (Y) Regt RA (V)

Formed in 1999, this provides a source of fully trained soldiers to their Regular Army counterparts in the North Luffenham-based 16th Regiment Royal Artillery. 106 Regiment is the only TA unit with soldiers trained to operate the world's most advanced short-range air defence missile system.



53. 221 Field Squadron (Explosive Ordnance Disposal) (V)

Part of 101 (City of London) Engineer Regiment EOD, this unique regiment is made up of five squadrons – three regular and two TA. It specialises in explosive ordnance disposal and search operations around the world and is based in Catford, London, and Rochester, Kent. The regiment's motto is 'Ubique', which is Latin for 'everywhere', which it really is!



54. St Dunstan's CCF Band

St Dunstan's College Combined Cadet Force is 100 years old. Its Corps of Drums was re-established in 2009, subsequently performing at CCF camps, the Help for Heroes St George's Day Parade in Whitehall and the Livery Club Luncheon at Stationers' Hall. Its membership continues to expand and now includes drums, bugles and fife.



55. Worshipful Company of Marketors

The Worshipful Company of Marketors is a Modern Livery Company with a Royal Charter. The Master's theme for 2012 is 'Marketing – the driving force in business performance'. Supported by the Chartered Institute of Marketing and St Dunstan's College (which is again providing the marching band to accompany the float), the Company's aim is to remind the City that marketing benefits everyone.

56. Sedbergh School

Sedbergh School, where Roger Gifford was educated, was founded in 1525 and has a national reputation for music and sport. The Combined Cadet Force band has performed for Her Majesty the Queen, and appeared at Lord's and the Mardi Gras Festival of Nice. It also tours internationally, most recently closing the Hong Kong Cathay Pacific International Chinese New Year's Night Parade.



57. Worshipful Society of Apothecaries

The Society of Apothecaries is the doctors' and pharmacists' Livery Company and has been involved in formal medical education since 1815. With 1,235 Liverymen, it has the largest Livery in the City and is the Mother Company of the Lady Mayoress, who is a haematologist by profession. It has the oldest hall in the City and continues to hold courses, lectures and postgraduate examinations in medical fields.
