for the payment of their Fines, as per List in the rough minute
Book.

The Committee then audited the Account of
William Gosper Keating Esq. Treasurer to this day inclusive
and found there was a balance due to him of Four Pounds
Seven Shillings and Sevenpence which Sum was paid by the
Master to the Treasurer, closing the account.
