 expended on their Account  $\overset{\text{£. s. d.}}{107^{\text{r}} 12^{\text{s}} 0^{\text{d}}}$  making a Balance  
 of  $\overset{\text{£. s. d.}}{45^{\text{r}} 2^{\text{s}} 2^{\text{d}}}$  due to him

The Clerk's Account for the last Year was also  
 audited And it appears thereby that his Fees,  
 Salary and monies expended by him for the Company  
 amount to  $\overset{\text{£. s. d.}}{33^{\text{r}} 2^{\text{s}} 6^{\text{d}}}$  and that he has received for their Use  
 $\overset{\text{£. s. d.}}{13^{\text{r}} 3^{\text{s}} 10^{\text{d}}}$  making a Balance of  $\overset{\text{£. s. d.}}{19^{\text{r}} 18^{\text{s}} 8^{\text{d}}}$  due to him.
