Patterns for the case were submitted by the Clerk, and a blue velvet pattern was selected, and the Clerk was instructed to have the inscription engraved upon a silver plate unless it was certain that the inscription would show up well on the velvet.

It was left to Sir Homewood Crawford to make arrangements for the presentation of the medal to the King directly the case was ready.

The ceremony of presentation took place at Buckingham Palace on Tuesday the 23rd March 1920 when the King received
