

The Report was adopted with the following amendments :-

- (a) that the Company's Grace be sung by the small choir after Dinner and that the words be printed in the programme
- (b) that Loving Cups be not dispensed with.

It was agreed that the Dinner should start at 7.15 pm and might be expected to continue well beyond 10.30 pm, and this might be stated in the circular letter to the Livery.

It was suggested that in addition to the proposed Chamber Concert a performance of Dr. Gordon Jacob's work might be arranged to be given by students of R. A. M. or R. C. M. Postmaster Schuster stated that it had been ascertained that this was not feasible because the students could not undertake the work outside their curriculum. Postmaster Allcard thought that the Guildhall School of Music might undertake it and Sir Denis Truscott offered to approach the Principal on the subject.
