

The Company's Music Loan Exhibition in commemoration of the Tercentenary of the granting by King James 1 of the Company's Second Charter of Incorporation and which was under the immediate patronage of His Majesty the King Her Majesty Queen Alexandra and Their Royal Highnesses The Prince and Princess of Wales was opened at Fishmongers Hall by Their Royal Highnesses the Prince and Princess of Wales on Monday the 27th June 1904 at 4 o'clock

The general guests assembled in the lower Dining Room and the Right Hon. The Lord Mayor and Lady Mayoress and the Sheriffs and their Ladies arrived at 3.45 and were received by the Master and Wardens

The Prince and Princess of Wales were received at the entrance to the Building by the Prime Warden of the Fishmongers Company (Henry Joseph Chinnery Esq) who was presented and who then presented George Lewis Denman Esq, Hugh Edwin Smith Esq and Bryan Osborne Durant Esq Wardens of his company

Their Royal Highnesses were then conducted upstairs to the entrance of the great Hall where they were received by the Master who was presented and who presented the Wardens and M^{rs} Herring and the latter presented a bouquet to the Princess of Wales - The Master then presented Sir Homewood Crawford, the Chairman of the Exhibition Committee, Lady Crawford, and Their Royal Highnesses accepted a copy of the Exhibition Catalogue from Lady Crawford
