

to the retiring Beadle of the Company
reported as follows:-

"The Committee beg to report to the Court that
in their opinion a sum of Thirty pounds
should be paid to Mr Walker the retiring Beadle
in recognition of his past services and would
suggest to the Court that from information
received from various sources as to salaries paid
to Beadles of other Companies similar to theirs
that a new Beadle's Salary should not exceed
Ten to Fourteen Guineas."

After discussion the Report was withdrawn
And thereupon

Mr Wilkinson moved

That a Pension of Ten Guineas per annum
being half the Salary received by the late Beadle
be paid to him during the pleasure of the Court.

Seconded by Mr Skilbeck

Carried unanimously
Mr Walker the Beadle undertakes to act as Beadle during the
pleasure of the Court on the same terms as heretofore.

A letter from Miss Biggs asking for relief
was read and Mr Skilbeck moved

That the sum of Three Guineas be
given to her as a Donation.

Seconded by Mr Frisby

Carried unanimously
