62. 306 Hospital Support Medical Regiment (V)

63. 256 (City of London) Field Hospital (Volunteers)

Medical specialists from the Field Hospital continue to provide medical, allied health and military support to current operations. The Field Hospital has also seen service as a formed unit in both Afghanistan and Iraq and is due to deploy to Helmand again in 2014.



64. 135 Geographic Squadron

The only unit in the Territorial Army dealing with mapping and imagery support to UK Armed Forces, 135 provides geographic support to Defence – such as surveying international boundaries, terrain analysis, the production and distribution of maps and geographic products. 135 has been involved in operations as diverse as the Balkans, Sierra Leone, Iraq and Afghanistan.



65. 41 (PLK) Signal Squadron (V)

41 Signal Squadron is a Territorial Army Signals Squadron. Constantly evolving and adapting to new requirements, it now has units in Coulsdon and Kingston-upon-Thames. Using the latest Bowman radio systems, its primary role is to provide reserve national and international communications resilience. Three of the unit's soldiers are currently deployed or deploying on operations.



66. 151 (London) Transport Regiment (V)

London's only transport regiment, this unit is well trained, operationally tested and highly motivated and as busy as any regular regiment, fully embracing the 'One Army' concept. It's a modern TA regiment operating in today's Army, with the principal role of ensuring that weapons, ammunition and supplies are delivered wherever and whenever they are needed.
