£100. 0. 0 Resolved that one hundred pounds
be advanced to the Master: which
was paid by the Treasurer -

Mr Chaplin moved & Mr J. Follows
seconded - that each Member of the
Court be empowered to introduce
two Visitors per Annum.

Carried Unanimously

Mr Wood moved, - Mr Jones seconded
that it be recommended to the
Members of the Court, - in the
Event of their intending to introduce
two Visitors on any one occasion,
to give previous Notice of such
intention to the Clerk.

Carried Unanimously

Resolved, That Mr Frostick be relieved at
the Master's Discretion, to the extent of two Guineas.
