

At a Committee of Assistants of the Worshipful  
Company of Musicians holden at the Albion, Aldersgate  
on Wednesday the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November 1836.

Present Mr. Rob<sup>t</sup>. Albion Fellows. Master  
Under Warden Pattison. — The Treasurer. — &  
Mess<sup>rs</sup>. Collard — Buttons — and Chaplin.

The account of Mr. Chaplin, was examined  
and compared with the several Vouchers produced, and  
found correct, and his Balance in hand of £53.3.6  
paid over to Mr. R. A. Fellows.

The Treasurer's Account leaving a Balance  
in his hands of £122.13.3. was examined, and  
found correct.

The Clerk's Account including the sum of  
Five Guineas voted to him by the Court for the extra  
services required of him by the late Municipal Enquiry  
was examined, and found to be correct, having a  
Balance due to him of £2.3.2.

The Beadle's Account was examined, and  
found correct — by which it appeared that the sum of  
£5.18.0 — had been collected for Quarterage, and it was  
paid over to the Masters.

The Stamp Book, was also compared  
with the admissions of Freeman, and found to be  
correct.
